These units are a particular variation of a previously approved model and, as such, are covered under the minor change clause of FAR, Part 21, Subpart O. The previously approved model is the AV-40E, P/N S-12500-(), and S-12550-() and the particular variation is that the original waist strap arrangement (two tie straps) has been replaced with a single waist strap with a plastic buckle. That particular waist strap assembly is approved in one of our other Models of life vests.
