







This unit is a particular variation of a previously approved model (ILV-20, P/N S-10000-( )), and as such is covered under the minor change clause of Part 21.

The new units differ from the old units in that they use a new, one-part, non-removable inflator (CO<sub>2</sub> cylinder holder/puncture device). This inflator has already been approved as part of our Model AV35, P/N S-51XXX-( ) and S-618XX-( ) series vests.
